- Abstract which does not need exceed 350 words in length. For samples, see Dissertation Specifications on the Office of the Registrar website: registrar.uconn.edu/doctoral-degree-programs
- Minimum margins for all pages of the dissertation and abstract are 1 inch on left and 1 inch on top, bottom, and right.
- Font and point size should be Arial, Times New Roman, and/or Helvetica with a point size of either 11 or 12.
- Dissertation text is double-spaced. Long quotations, footnotes, appendices, and references are single-spaced.
- Pagination – Preliminary pages (e.g., title page, optional copyright page, approval page, acknowledgements, table of contents) are numbered consecutively using lower case Roman numerals. The title page number may be suppressed. All pages of the text, appendices, and references must be numbered consecutively using Arabic numerals. The abstract is not paginated. Page number locations should be consistent throughout the document.
- Sequence of main components will be as follows: abstract, title page, copyright page (optional), approval page, acknowledgments, table of contents, the text, appendices (if any), and references. The order of the appendices and the references may be reversed if the appendices are lengthy.
- Footnotes, endnotes, and references should follow the format that is accepted in your discipline or that is prescribed by your advisory committee.
- Print should be clear, clean, and dark with no shadows or stray marks. Remember to remove tracking changes. Photographs, graphics, and scanned images should be high quality and can be in color.
- If photocopied journal articles will be included, written permission must be granted and included. For more details, see Dissertation Specifications on the Office of the Registrar website: registrar.uconn.edu/doctoral-degree-programs.
- The Approval Page of the dissertation will be printed on 8.5 x 11 inch white paper with original signatures.

Failure to adhere to formatting and preparation requirements may delay conferral of the student's degree.
